Brenda Waltermire as she has a hysterectomy & gallbladder surgery on May 16 at Regional Hospital.


Jeff Zelensky as he has surgery on May 24.

OUTREACH – LOVE WASH – ST. MARK'S

SHARE A QUARTER, SHOW SOMEONE YOU CARE

Outreach will be collecting quarters to help with St. Mark UCC's "Love Wash" program again this year. There will be a collection tube at church for you to drop quarters into and watch the amount grow as more and more quarters fill the tube! Kids will especially like doing this and seeing how their donations increase. NOTE: you may also give with a check or cash but please denote that it's for the LOVE WASH Outreach Collection. Donations will then be converted to quarters so we can all see them add up!

If you're unfamiliar with this program, St. Mark collects quarters to provide free clothes washing and drying at local laundromats for those that might not have a means to wash their clothing. Each person will be given up to \$5.00 in quarters for washing and \$5.00 in quarters for drying as well as laundry pods and dryer fabric softener sheets. Representatives from St. Mark will post what days they will be available and at what laundromat to provide this service. Clothes must be washed at that time and no laundry pods or dryer sheets can be taken home. This service will continue as long as there is money to fund it. There will be flyers available explaining the program in more detail and explaining how it got started.

CCC Outreach also will continue collecting soups and granola bars for United Campus Ministry's food pantry throughout the remainder of 2022. Thank you for your generous donations to date!

Rebecca's Revelation

Grace and peace to you in the name of the Risen Christ and Happy Eastertide! I hope you are experiencing some of the resurrection, new life and transformation that comes with this season of the church year. I also hope you feel encouraged as we continue our shared work and ministry building God's realm in our corner of the world. One of the ways we try to do this is through an outreach ministry first created by Mary Beth Mullen. The process that we practice can be a help to those in need *and* keep church staff and members safe.

If you are in the church building or on the property and someone approaches you for help, please do not give them money. Some well-intentioned folks have done this, but then several persons have returned to the building, and when staff tell them we do not keep cash on hand, they have become aggressive. People can do awful things when they are at a point of desperation. We have not had to call the police for such situations for a number of years, but it has happened.

If Brie, Mary Beth, or I are at the church, please refer individuals to us.

If we are not there, let the person know that we do not keep cash on hand. You can take the person's name and number and tell them you will pass it on to staff.

If we have Gas/Grocery cards in the office, we can make a one-time gift of a card and they must sign a small sheet attached to the Gas Card stating that they understand this. After the person signs the sheet, we then have a way of keeping track of those we have helped. Also attached to the Gas/Grocery card is a list of local resources for shelter, food, etc.

If an individual indicates that more help is needed, take their name and phone number and slip it under the office door. Please do not give them Brie's or my home contact information.

If you would like to contribute to this Resource Outreach Ministry, you can bring Gas/ Grocery cards (Kroger, Walmart) to the church office in amounts of \$10, \$15, or \$20. As followers of Jesus Christ, we want to help those in need. We need to be smart and good stewards of our resources as well as keep everyone safe.
