Voices of the Generations brings the Holocaust into personal focus through the story of Julie Kohner's parents, Hanna and Walter. Hanna survived four concentration camps, including Auschwitz, and later shared her experiences as a Holocaust survivor, notably on the national television series, *This Is Your Life*.

After her mother's death in 1990, Julie created Voices of the Generations to preserve and share her mother's story and the stories of other Holocaust survivors. For more than 35 years, Julie has carried on this work, sharing her family's history with audiences across the United States and internationally.

Through her parents' story of love, survival, and resilience, Julie offers a personal perspective on the Holocaust and the importance of remembering and preserving these stories for future generations.
